Block IX, Aohanga Survey District; thence along the northern boundary-line of that section to the westernmost corner of Section 18, Block V, Aohanga Survey District; thence by the western and southern boundaries of that section to the Waiowaka Road; thence along the western side of Waiowaka Road to Spur Road; thence along the northern and eastern side of Spur Road to the road forming the northern boundary of Sections 7 and 6, Block XI, Aohanga Survey District; thence by that road and the north-eastern boundary of said Section 6 to its easternmost corner; thence along the southern and eastern boundaries of Section 5, Block XI, Aohanga Survey District, to the Waingongora Stream; thence by that stream to its confluence with the Aohanga River; and thence by the Aohanga River to the sea, the place of commencement.

And I hereby declare that this Proclamation shall come into operation on the first day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine.

A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the power and authority vested in the Governor-General by the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1924, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby abolish the existing registration districts known as the Mauriceville, Carterton, Masterton, and Castlepoint districts, and do proclaim and declare that the territory heretofore comprised within the said districts is hereby divided anew into three registration districts, the names whereof shall be the Masterton, Carterton, and Castlepoint districts, and the boundaries whereof shall be coextensive with the boundaries of the marriage districts bearing the same names as are set forth in a Proclamation of even date herewith, made under the provisions of the Marriage Act, 1908:

And I hereby declare that this Proclamation shall come into operation on the first day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine.
