

Notice of Intention to take Additional Land in the Borough of Hamilton for Housing Purposes.

Declaring Area to be a Closely Populated Locality for the Purposes of the Motor-vehicles Amendment Act, 1936, Section 3.

IN terms of section 3 of the Motor-vehicles Amendment Act, 1936, the Minister of Transport does hereby declare the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a closely populated locality for the purposes of the said section to the intent that a person driving any motor-vehicle on any road, street, or other place to which the public have access therein, shall be subject to the maximum speed-limit of thirty miles an hour fixed by the said section.

All that area at Okato consisting of that portion of the Lepperton Junction-Hawera via Opunake Main Highway No. 36 commencing at a point 15 chains measured along the said main highway in a north-westerly direction from its junction with Gossling Street, proceeding thence in a south-easterly and north-easterly direction, and terminating at a point 10 chains measured along the said main highway in a north-easterly direction from its junction with the Oxford-Saunders Main Highway, a distance of approximately 40 chains.
