## NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TAKE LAND IN THE CITY OF WELLINGTON FOR HOSPITAL PURPOSES.

NOTICE is hereby given that it is proposed by the Wellington Hospital Board under the provisions of the Public Works Act, 1928, to take the land described in the Schedule hereto for hospital purposes; and notice is hereby further given that the plan of the land so to be taken is deposited at the offices of Messrs. Brandon, Ward, Hislop, and Powles, Solicitors, 150 Featherston Street, Wellington, and is there open for inspection; and that all persons affected by the taking of such land should, if they have any well-grounded objections to the taking of such land, set forth the same in writing, and send such writing within forty days from the first publication of this notice to the Wellington Hospital Board at Wellington.

## SCHEDULE.

Approximate areas of the pieces of land to be taken:—
