RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

Sewerage and other Miscellaneous Works Renewal Loan, 1940.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and in pursuance and exercise of all other Acts, powers, and authorities enabling it in this behalf, the Gisborne Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the interest, principal, and other charges on a special loan of £151,800, to be known as Sewerage and other Miscellaneous Works Renewal Loan, 1940, authorized to be raised by the Gisborne Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose (together with accrued sinking funds and together with the sum of £16,705 to be paid to the Council by the Poverty Bay Electric-power Board in respect of certain electric works taken over by the said Board) of repaying Sewerage and other Miscellaneous Works Loan, 1910, which matures on the 15th day of October, 1940, the said Gisborne Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one penny and sixty-one sixths of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property of the Borough of Gisborne, comprising the whole of the Borough of Gisborne; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the first day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty years from the 14th day of October, 1940, or until the loan is fully paid off.”

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and of all other powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Franklin County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of ten thousand pounds (£10,000), authorized to be raised by the Franklin County Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of making advances to farmers for erection of dwellings under the Rural Housing Act, 1939, the said Franklin County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-thirtieth of a penny (1/30d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the County of Franklin; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the first day of October in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five years, or until the loan is fully paid off.”
