TUAKAU TOWN BOARD.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

THE following resolution was duly passed at a meeting of the Tuakau Town Board held on Monday, the 1st day of July, 1940, namely:—

"In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Tuakau Town Board hereby resolves as follows: That, for the purpose of providing the instalments of principal and interest and other charges on a loan of £1,000 (one thousand pounds), authorized to be raised by the Tuakau Town Board under the above-mentioned Act, to be known as the 'Road Improvement Loan, 1940,' for the purpose of reconstructing and sealing certain roads and footpaths in the Tuakau Town District, the said Tuakau Town Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of $\frac{3}{16}$ d. (three-sixteenths of one penny) in the pound upon the rateable value (based upon the capital value) of all rateable property in the Tuakau Town District; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 31st day of March in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of eight years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
