RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

Electrical Generation Loan No. 2, 1941 (£13,000).

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Otago Central Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of thirteen thousand pounds (£13,000), authorized to be raised by the Otago Central Electric-power Board under the above-mentioned Act for the construction of additional headworks and a further generating station at Roaring Meg Stream, together with an access road to the site of the new works, the said Otago Central Electric-power Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of three-tenths of a penny ($\frac{3}{10}$ d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the Otago Central Electric-power District comprising the whole of the Board's Inner Area."
