NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TAKE LAND FOR A ROAD AND TO STOP A ROAD

In the matter of the Counties Act, 1920, and the Public Works Act, 1928.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Cook County Council proposes, under the provisions of the above-mentioned Acts, to execute a certain public work—namely, the construction of a road and the closing of a road—and for the purposes of such public work the lands described in the First Schedule hereto are required to be taken and the road shown in the Second Schedule hereto is required to be stopped: And notice is hereby further given that a plan of the land so to be taken and of the road to be stopped is deposited in the public office of the Clerk to the said Council, situate in the Council Chambers, Childers Road, Gisborne, and is open for inspection (without fee) during ordinary office hours.

All persons affected by the said public work or by the taking of such lands or by stopping of such road who have any well-grounded objections to the execution of the public work, or to the taking of the said lands, or the stopping of the said road, must state their objection in writing, and send the same, within forty days from the first publication of this notice, to the County Clerk at the Council Chambers, Childers Road, Gisborne.
