1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 785, and shall be read together with and deemed part of Price Order No. 612† (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

2. This Order shall come into force on the 21st day of November, 1947.

3. The principal Order, as amended by Price Order No. 728‡, is hereby further amended as follows:—

- (a) By inserting after the word "raisins" in clause 4 the words "imported from Australia";
- (b) By omitting from paragraphs (a), (b), and (c) of subclause (1) of clause 6 the words "(whether imported from Australia or elsewhere)".
