"(a) The western side of the portion of College Street adjoining Lots 35 and 36, Deeds Plan 46, Township of St.

Andrews;

"(b) The eastern side of the portion of Peter Street adjoining part Lot 24, Block II, Deeds Plan 93, being part Section 20, Block VI, Town District;

"such land being comprised and described in Certificate of Title 264/32;
