Plants Declared Noxious Weeds in the Borough of Whangarei (Notice No. Ag. 5505)

PURSUANT to the Noxious Weeds Act 1950, the Director-General of Agriculture, acting under a delegation from the Minister of Agriculture for the purposes of the said Act, hereby publishes the following special order made by the Whangarei Borough Council on the 12th day of August 1953.

SPECIAL ORDER

THAT in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 3 of the Noxious Weeds Act 1950 and all other powers enabling it, the Whangarei Borough Council hereby resolves by way of special order that the plants mentioned in the Schedule hereto be and are hereby declared noxious weeds within the borough of Whangarei.

PURSUANT to section 13 of the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, I hereby give notice that at a poll of the ratepayers of the Bay of Islands Harbour District, taken on the 28th day of August 1953 on the proposal of the Bay of Islands Harbour Board to borrow the sum of one hundred and ninety-eight thousand pounds (£198,000) for the purpose of

(1) Erecting a new wharf and other miscellaneous harbour works at or in the vicinity of Opuia in the Bay of Islands County; and

(2) Dredging the Veronica Channel at Bay of Islands. The number of votes recorded for the proposal was 2,066. The number of votes recorded against the proposal was 288.
