Exemption Order Under the Motor Drivers Regulations 1940

A motor driver's licence, issued under the Motor Drivers Regulations 1940 to the persons described in column 1 of the Schedule hereunder, may authorise them to drive a heavy trade motor in the course of their employment for the employers described in column 2 of the said Schedule, but shall not authorise them, while they are under the age of eighteen years, to drive a heavy trade motor for any other purpose. purpose.

Special Order Made by Grey County Council Altering Riding Boundaries and Adjusting Representation

SPECIAL ORDER

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 23 and 60 of the Counties Act 1920, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, the Grey County Council hereby resolves by way of special order as follows:

"1. That the Grey County Council shall consist of nine members, who shall be elected as follows:

"(a) The electors of the North Riding shall elect three councillors:
"(b) The electors of the East Riding shall elect four councillors:

"(c) The electors of the South Riding shall elect two councillors.

"2. That the area of Te Kinga, Rotomanu, Inchbonnie, Poerua, Mitchells, Taramakau Settlement to the Taramakau River, and also the built-up area of Kaiata, be transferred from the South Riding to the East Riding, and that the boundaries of the said ridings be those as are more particularly described in the Schedule hereto.

"3. The alteration hereby made shall take effect on and after the next general election of councillors on the 17th day of November 1956, or such other date as the Minister of Internal Affairs shall decide."

The foregoing special order having been passed at a special meeting held on 29 March 1956, and confirmed at a subsequent meeting held on 10 May 1956, the common seal of the Chairman, Councillors, and Inhabitants of the County of Grey was by resolution of the said Council hereunto affixed this 12th day of July 1956.
