## AWATERE COUNTY COUNCIL

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, the Counties Act 1920, and all other Acts and powers it thereunto enabling, the Awatere County Council hereby resolves:

"That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of principal, interest, and other charges on the Pensioners' Flats Loan of three thousand pounds (£3,000) authorised to be raised by the Council under the above-mentioned Acts for the purpose of erecting pensioners' flats, the said Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of three one-hundredths of a penny (0.03d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the County of Awatere, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable annually on the 13th day of September in each and every year during the currency of such loan until the loan is fully paid off."
