NEW LYNN BOROUGH COUNCIL

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

THAT, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the New Lynn Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £8,000 authorised to be raised by the New Lynn Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for housing purposes, the said New Lynn Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of decimal one one pence (0.11d.) in the pound (£) on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the Borough of New Lynn; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable on the 30th day of May in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty (20) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
