45. Checked Luggage

Paragraph 1, subparagraph (e): *Omit* this subparagraph.  
 Paragraph 3: *Omit* the last sentence from this paragraph, and *substitute* the following:  
 The passenger's railway or motor ticket, or railway and steamer ticket (for inter-island checked luggage), must be produced before luggage will be accepted for checking.  
 Paragraph 8: *Omit* this paragraph.

Paragraph 10: *Omit* this paragraph.

54. Parcels Traffic, Conditions of Carriage, and Classification

Paragraph 8:

62. Newspapers and Stereotype Casts

Paragraph 1, subparagraph (c): *Omit* this subparagraph, and *substitute* the following:  
 (c) Charges on packages conveyed under this regulation must, except as provided in paragraph 2 hereof, be prepaid by cash or ledger account.  
 Paragraph 1, subparagraph (g): *Omit* the heading "Rates for Stamped Parcels", and *substitute* "Rates".  
 Paragraph 2, subparagraph (a): *Omit* this subparagraph, and *substitute* the following:  
 (a) Newspaper proprietors must send to the railway station with each lot of newspapers or periodicals a consignment note or other form of approved list showing the number of packages for each station, together with the total weight of the whole consignment.  
 Paragraph 5: *Omit* this paragraph, and *substitute* the following:  
 5. Stereotype carried at the rates shown above must be prepaid.
