SPECIAL ORDER

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 23 of the Counties Act 1956, the Hokianga County Council resolves, by way of special order, as follows:

1. To alter the present boundaries of the various ridings in order to give due representation to such additional factors considered relevant by the Council.

2. The amended descriptions of the said ridings are respectively described in the Schedule hereunder.

3. The alterations defined above to take effect at the general election of councillors to be held on 13 October 1962, except in so far and to such extent as may be necessary to provide for that election.
