PURSUANT to the provisions of section 23 of the Counties Act PURSUANT to the provisions of section 23 of the Counties Act 1956, the Otamatea County Council hereby resolves by way of special order to alter the number of ridings within the county by abolishing the existing Matakohe Riding and by establishing in lieu thereof two new ridings, namely, the Matakohe and Hukatere Ridings. The boundaries of the said Matakohe and Hukatere Ridings shall be as described in the Schedule hereto, and the alteration herein described shall come into force at the next general election of the Council on the 13th day of October 1962, except in so far and to such extent as may be necessary for providing for that election.
