PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Empowering (Aviation Encouragement) Act 1929, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Hawke's Bay Aerodrome Establishment Order 1962.

2. Consent is hereby given to the establishment and maintenance of an aerodrome by the Napier City Council, the Hastings City Council, the Havelock North Borough Council, the Hawke's Bay County Council, and the Taradale Borough Council on the land described in the Schedule hereto.

3. (1) The notice, published in the *Gazette* of 14 February 1935 at page 320, constituting the Napier Aero Club a recognised Aviation Authority is hereby revoked.

(2) The notice, published in the *Gazette* of 18 October 1945 at page 1300, constituting the Napier Borough Council a recognised Aviation Authority is hereby revoked.

(3) The notice, published in the *Gazette* of 13 June 1946 at page 812, consenting to the establishment and maintenance of an aerodrome by the Napier Borough Council is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE
