

CLUTHA COUNTY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Clutha County Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £30,000 authorised to be raised by the Clutha County Council under the above-named Act for the purpose of making advances to farmers in terms of the Rural Housing Act 1939, the Clutha County Council hereby makes a special rate of one hundred and twenty-nine thousandths of a penny in the pound (0.129d. in £) upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the whole of the County of Clutha; and that the special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable on the 30th day of June in each and every year during the currency of the loan until the loan is fully paid off."

In Special Rating Area Forming Part of Upper Hutt Subdivision of the Hutt River District
