

WAITOMO ELECTRIC POWER BOARD

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Renewal Loan 1964 of £20,000

PURSUANT to section 47 of the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, as amended by the 1959 and 1961 Amendment Acts, the Waitomo Electric Power Board hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a renewal loan of £20,000 authorised to be raised by the Waitomo Electric Power Board under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of repaying on maturity those portions of the General Extension Loan 1958, Building Completion Loan 1954, and Reticulation Loan 1954, which mature on 1 July and 1 December 1964, the said Waitomo Electric Power Board hereby makes a special rate of nine fiftieths of one penny (9/50d.) in the pound (£) upon the rateable value (on the basis of unimproved value) of all rateable property in the Waitomo Electric Power District; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of July in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 10 years, or until the loan is fully paid off".

TARARUA ELECTRIC POWER BOARD

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Tararua Electric Power Board hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the principal interest and other charges on a loan of £10,700 (to be known as Redemption Loan 1964) authorised to be raised by the Tararua Electric Power Board in New Zealand by "consent" under the above-mentioned Act and of all other Acts and authorities it thereunto enabling for the purpose of repaying on maturity those portions of the Akitio Reticulation Loan 1953 of £5,000 and the Inner Area Loan 1953 of £13,000 which mature on the 1st day of August 1964, together with those portions of the Akitio Loan 1954, £2,500, and the Inner Area Loan 1954, £7,000, which mature on the 1st day of October 1964, the said Tararua Electric Power Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of $\frac{9}{1000}$ (point nought seven nine) of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of unimproved value) of all the rateable property in the Tararua Electric Power District as defined in the *Gazette*, No. 31, of the 22nd day of May 1958, at pages 652 and 653; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of ten (10) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
