PURSUANT to section 3 of the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Whitianga Harbour Order 1964.
2. The area described in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be the limits of the Whitianga Harbour.
3. The Warrant dated the 1st day of April 1925* defining the limits of Mercury Bay Harbour is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

ALL that area in the South Auckland Land District, Coromandel County, bounded by a line commencing at a point on the mean high-water mark in Block X, Otama Survey District, being the northernmost corner of part Weiti No. 1 Block (recreation reserve), D.P. 23068; thence generally southerly, easterly, and northerly, by the line of mean high water of the Whitianga Harbour in Block X, aforesaid, and in Block I, Whitianga Survey District, to a point on the line of mean high water, in Block VII, Otama Survey District, bearing 313° 40', distance 10 links from iron spike X on D.P. S. 6867; thence south-westerly by a right line to the point of commencement.
