Mill Point	Block V, Titirangi Survey District, Manukau Harbour, point north-east of Mill Bay.
Te Puna Inlet	Bay of Islands, Kerikeri Survey District. Instead of Ti Mangonui Inlet notified in <i>Gazette</i> , No. 42, of 29 July 1948, page 939.

HAWKE'S BAY LAND DISTRICT

Lake Opouahi	Block VIII, Maungaharuru Survey District. Nine miles inland from Lake Tutira by the Pohukura Road. Instead of "Lake Opowehe".
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TARANAKI LAND DISTRICT

Carex Peak	Egmont National Park—North-West Egmont Pouakai Range, on highest point of spur running from Bell Falls toward Pouakai Trig. 4,387 ft.
Kahui Hill	Egmont National Park, West Egmont, west of and below Kahui Hut, 3,678 ft.
Kiri Peak	Egmont National Park, North-West Egmont, on Pouakai Range, near the head of Kiri Stream and Momona Stream, a tributary of the Oakura River.
Puniho Hill	Egmont National Park, West Egmont, at head of Puniho Track, 2,832 ft.

MARLBOROUGH LAND DISTRICT

Echo Stream	Blocks V and VI, Pine Valley Survey District. Tributary of Richmond Stream which flows into Pelorus River.
Fishtail Stream	Blocks II, VI, and VII, Pine Valley Survey District. Large tributary of Pelorus River with source below Mount Fishtail.
Johnson Peak	Block XI, Pine Valley Survey District. Richmond Range, due east of Mount Richmond Trig. Station.
Richmond Saddle	Block XI, Pine Valley Survey District. Pass west of Mount Richmond Trig.
Richmond Stream	Blocks V, VI, and XI Pine Valley Survey District. Tributary of Pelorus River. Source below Mount Richmond.

NELSON LAND DISTRICT

Billhook Point	Block II, D'Urville Survey District. Southern point of Billhook Bay.
Black Reef Bay	Block VI, D'Urville Survey District. At north-west extremity of boundary between Sections 5A and 6A, Rangitoto Block.
Bullock Bay	Block X, D'Urville Survey District. Small bay on west shore of Smylies Arm.
Camping Bay	Block X, D'Urville Survey District. In Greville Harbour between Trigs. South Boulder and Double Point.
Deserter Bay	Block VIII, D'Urville Survey District. On south shore of East Arm, Port Hardy, adjoining Section 10.
Fryingpan Point	Block X, D'Urville Survey District. Approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ mile south-west of Ragged Point, at north-west corner of Section 3B 4A, Rangitoto Block.
Hells Gate	Block II, D'Urville Survey District. Rocks at north-east tip of Cape Stephens.
Kupe Bay	Block XIV, D'Urville Survey District. Between Trigs. E and F.
Lookout Bay	Block III, D'Urville Survey District. Between Nile Head and Trafalgar Point.
Low Neck Bay	Block VIII, D'Urville Survey District. Bay between Old Man Point and the intersection of the south-west boundary of Section 10 with the eastern shoreline.
