

Name	Situation and Remarks
Rome Ridge	Block V, Arthur's Pass Survey District. Runs easterly from Mount Rolleston to Trig J.
Snow Creek	Block X, Bealey Survey District. Flows easterly into Bealey River opposite Brett Stream.
Stag Hill	Block VII, Harper Survey District. Between Fall Creek and Hamilton Creek.
The Braes	Blocks VIII and XII, Mytholm Survey District. The north-west slopes of "The Roderick Peak".
The Hooligan	Blocks X and XI, Mytholm Survey District. Instead of Mytholm Range.
The Panhandle	Block IX, Okuku Survey District. Spur running north-south. West of Okuku River and north of Mount Gordon.
The Pinnacles	Block XIV, Harper Survey District. North of Trig. DD. Prominent landmark on right bank of Harper River.
Wall Creek	Block XII, Harper Survey District. Rises south of Mount Wall and flows south-east into Broken River.
Waterfall Creek	Blocks XV and XVI, Harper Survey District. Northern branch of Hogs Back Creek.
Woolshed Ridge	Blocks VIII and XII, Katrine Survey District. Watershed between Lake Taylor and South Branch, Hurunui River.
Wharfedale Road	Block XII, Upper Ashley Survey District. Instead of "Wharfedale".

SOUTHLAND LAND DISTRICT

Archer Point	Doubtful Sound, Fiordland National Park. In Deep Cove, approximately 50 chains north-west of Brasell Point.
Brasell Point	Doubtful Sound, Fiordland National Park. At southern end of Deep Cove, between the mouth of Lyvia River and Huntleigh Falls.
Doubtful Sound	Fiordland National Park. Name to apply to full length of Sound from the sea coast to Deep Cove.
Helena Anchorage	Doubtful Sound, Fiordland National Park. At southern end of Deep Cove, north and slightly east of the mouth of Lyvia River.
Lake Beattie	Fiordland National Park. On Coal River, north of Breaksea Sound. Approximately 2 miles from mouth of river.
Lake Herries	Fiordland National Park. In Kepler Mountains. Approximately 2 miles north-west of Spire Peak. Drains into tributary of Freeman Burn, Lake Manapouri.
Malaspina Reach	Doubtful Sound, Fiordland National Park. To be applied to that portion of the Sound from Flurry Head (Bauza Island) to Kellard Point.
Matai Island	Doubtful Sound, Fiordland National Park. On the north-eastern side of the sound, about one mile south-east of Espinosa Point.
Mount Danae	Fiordland National Park. Peak at head of Hall Arm, Doubtful Sound, 4,800 ft.
Shelter Cove	Doubtful Sound, Fiordland National Park. Small cove about 30 chains north-west of Solitary Cone.
Utah Island	Doubtful Sound, Fiordland National Park. In Gaol Passage, south of Bauza Island.
Wanganella Cove	Doubtful Sound, Fiordland National Park. In Deep Cove, west of Brasell Point. The Huntleigh Falls drains into this cove.

NOTE—All names of alpine features are assigned subject to fixation of the relative features on maps.
