*Maungaraki Development Loan (No. 5) 1964, £45,000*

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of forty-five thousand pounds (£45,000), authorised to be raised by the Lower Hutt City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of developing land for housing at Maungaraki, the said Lower Hutt City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of nine hundred and eighty-three thousandths of a penny (0·983d.) in the pound (£) on the rateable value (on the basis of the annual value) of all rateable property in the City of Lower Hutt; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be incorporated and added to the consolidated special rate made pursuant to the provisions of section 108A of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954, and be payable yearly on or about the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of 3 years, or until such time as the loan is paid off."
