NOTICE OF PRIVATE BILL

CHURCH OF ENGLAND EMPOWERING AMENDMENT ACT 1966

NOTICE is hereby given that a Commission consisting of the Most Reverend Norman Alfred Lesser, Archbishop and Primate of New Zealand, the Reverend Walter Wade Robinson, Mr Hurren Martin Stanhope Dawson, Mr Wybrants Olphert, and Mr Ivan Everard Fitchett appointed by the General Synod of the Church of the Province of New Zealand (commonly called The Church of England) to represent the General Synod and to act in its name and on its behalf in the promotion of the above Bill, proposes to apply for leave to bring into the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled during its present session a Private Bill the objects of which are:

1. To remove any doubts as to whether the General Synod may authorise different forms of service in different parts of the Province;
2. To vary the period within which any alteration to the formularies shall be confirmed by the General Synod; and
3. To enable the General Synod to permit the experimental use of new or amended forms of service under such conditions and for such periods as it shall determine; and
4. To amend the Church of England Empowering Act 1928 in order to give effect to the above-mentioned objects.

The promoter of this Private Bill is the said Commission of five persons named hereinabove.
