Revoking a Proclamation Defining the Middle Line of a Transmission Line in Blocks VI, IX, and X, Christchurch Survey District, viz, the Islington-Papanui 66kV Trans-mission Line (Waitaki Power Scheme)

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Sir Arthur Espie PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 11928, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Bartonet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby revoke the Proclamation, dated the 23rd day of August 1950, and published in the Gazette on the 31st day of the same month at page 1644, defining the middle line of a transmission line in Blocks VI, IX, and X, Christchurch Survey District, viz, the Islington-Papanui 66kV Transmission Line (Waitaki Power Scheme), in so far as it affects the land described in the Schedule hereto.
