A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 2 of the Maori Housing Amendment Act 1938, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the Proclamation published in the *Gazette* on the 24th day of October 1968, No. 67, at page 1961, be and the same is hereby revoked to the extent of the land described in the First Schedule hereto, and in substitution therefor the Crown land, described in the Second Schedule hereto, is hereby set apart for the purposes of the Maori Housing Act 1935.
