The Motor Launch (Rakaia Lagoon) Notice 1972-Ellesmere County Council

PURSUANT to the Motor Launch Regulations 1962\*, the Minister of Marine and Fisheries hereby gives the following

1. (a) This notice may be cited as the Motor Launch (Rakaia Lagoon) Notice 1972.
(b) This notice shall come into force on the 24th day of February 1972, and shall remain in force until further notice.

2. Subject to the conditions set forth in the Second Schedule hereto, regulation 11 of the Motor Launch Regulations 1962 shall not apply with respect to the area described in the First Schedule hereto.

# FIRST SCHEDULE

ALL that area of water known as Rakaia Lagoon at the mouth of the Rakaia River.

### SECOND SCHEDULE

- 1. No person shall propel or navigate a powered vessel at a proper speed greater than 5 miles an hour when—
  - (a) Within 100 ft of any other vessel; or
  - (b) Within 100 ft of any person in the water, or bathing, or fishing; or (c) Within 100 ft of any buoyed fishing net.
- 2. At each point in the area specified in the First Schedule hereto, where powered vessels are normally launched, there shall be erected a notice board, measuring not less than 2 ft 6 in. by 2 ft, painted bright orange, with black lettering in the following form:

RAKAIA LAGOON MOTOR LAUNCH REGULATIONS 1962 The following replace regulation 11:

- (1) No person shall propel or navigate a powered vessel at a proper speed greater than 5 miles an hour when—

  - (a) Within 100 ft of any other vessel; or (b) Within 100 ft of any person in the water, or bathing, or fishing; or (c) Within 100 ft of any buoyed fishing net.
