Price Order No. 2233 (Amendment No. 2 of Price Order No. 2189) (Spirits and Beer)

PURSUANT to the Control of Prices Act 1947, the Price Tribunal hereby makes the following price order:

- 1. This order may be cited as Price Order No. 2233 and shall be read together with and deemed part of Price Order No. 2189\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).
- 2. This order shall come into force on the 12th day of May 1973.
  - 3. In this order, unless the context otherwise requires— "Auckland Metropolitan Area" means the district com-prising the counties of Franklin and Waitemata including all cities, boroughs, and town districts situated within or contiguous to the boundaries of any such county.
- 4. The principal order is hereby amended by revoking clause 6 (1) (n) of the principal order and substituting the following clause:
  - (n) For beer sold in bottles containing 1 quart:

Auckland Metropolitan Area: the authorised price per bottle ruling at the particular premises on 11 May 1973, increased by 1 cent per bottle.

Elsewhere in New Zealand: the authorised price per bottle ruling at the particular premises on 21 December 1971, increased by 2 cents per bottle.
