That, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Counties Act 1956 and amendments thereto enabling it, the Mackenzie County Council hereby resolves by way of Special Order as follows:

- (a) To increase the number of members of the Mackenzie County Council from 9 to 10 members.
  (b) To increase the number of ridings from 5 to 6 Ridings.
  (c) To alter the boundaries of the existing Tekapo Riding by excluding therefrom the area described in the Schedule attached.
- (d) To constitute the area described in the Schedule attached as a separate riding of the Mackenzie County Council
- with one representative on the said council.

  (e) To name the new riding the Twizel Riding and to further resolve that its constitution become effective as from the 1977 local authority elections.
