1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Kapiti College Board of Governors Notice 1977.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1977.

2. The Board of Governors of Kapiti College shall be constituted as follows:

- (b) One member elected by the teachers of the schools controlled by the board;

- (f) Two members elected by the parents of the pupils attending the school, being parents who are resident in the Raumati school district;
- (g) One member elected by the parents of the pupils attending the school, being parents who are resident in the Raumati South school district;
