S. 18413, and south-easterly along the north-eastern boundary of the last-mentioned Lot 2 to the northern side of Matapihi Road; thence by right line to the westernmost point of part Section 7, Block XI, Tauranga Survey District, shown on D.P. 26202; thence south-easterly along the south-western boundaries of parts Sections 7, 3, and 5, Block XI, Tauranga Survey District, shown on D.P. 26202, the south-western boundary of part Papamoa No. 2 Section 11B shown on D.P. 26202, and generally north-easterly along the southern and south-eastern boundaries of the last-mentioned block and the production of the south-western boundary to the western side of State Highway No. 2; and proceeding along that side to a point on the production of the north-western boundary of Papamoa No. 2 Section 10A1 Block; and proceeding north-easterly along that production, crossing the State highway to and along the last-mentioned boundary and along the north-western boundaries of Papamoa No. 2 Sections 10A2C1 and 10A2C2 Blocks, to the southern side of Maranui Street; thence by right line across that street to and along the western boundary of Papamoa No. 2 Section 10A2C4 Block to the point of commencement.
