A PROCLAMATION

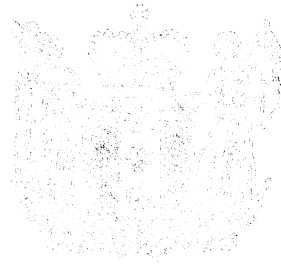
