IMPORT CONTROL REGULATIONS 1973
AMENDMENT TO CALL FOR TENDERS—ROUND 47

PURSUANT to regulation 9A (2A) of the Import Control Regulations 1973 (as inserted by regulation 2 of the Import Control Regulations 1973, Amendment No. 6), the Minister of Trade and Industry hereby gives notice that the notice on pages 2289 to 2292 of the *Gazette* of 22 May 1987 calling for tenders for Round 47 of the import licence tender scheme is amended as follows:

- (i) By omitting from the description of goods for which import licence offered under tender number 5710 is available the words “, other than fish based”; and
- (ii) By revoking the following items:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The purpose of this notice is to correct errors in the *Gazette* notice of 22 May 1987 calling for tenders for Round 47 of the import licence tendering scheme.

The effect of the amendments is—

- (i) To remove the restriction “,other than fish based” from the description of goods for which import licence offered under tender number 5710 is available; and
- (ii) To revoke all tenders which were given the numbers 5716 to 5723 inclusive. As each of those numbers appeared twice in the original *Gazette* notice it is necessary to revoke the relevant part of the notice.

AMENDMENT TO CALL FOR TENDERS—ROUND 48
TYRE AND TUBE INDUSTRY DEVELOPMENT PLAN

PURSUANT to regulation 9A (2A) of the Import Control Regulations 1973 (as inserted by regulation 2 of the Import Control Regulations 1973, Amendment No. 6), the Minister of Trade and Industry hereby gives notice that the notice on pages 2293 to 2298 of the *Gazette* of 25 May 1987 calling for tenders for Round 48 of the import licence tender scheme is amended by revoking so much of the notice as relates to the Tyre and Tube Industry Development Plan (including tender numbers 5822, 5823 and 5824).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

HOW TO USE THIS FORM

1. The bidding panels may be used for different tender numbers or any number of bidding panels may be used for the same tender number.
2. Tenderers may bid for any number of the licence units available under any tender number (unless otherwise stated in the *Gazette*)
3. Licence units may be bid for at various premium levels per unit including zero bids. Zero bids should be entered as 0.
4. Licence units are \$2,000 c.i.f. each unless otherwise stated in the *Gazette*.
5. One licence will be issued for all successful bids under each tender number (regardless of how many panels are used for that tender number). One invoice will be issued for the total premiums payable under each tender number.

CHECK LIST

1. Type in the tender number(s) for the goods required as listed in the Call for Tenders.
2. Type in the number of licence units sought in each tender number.
3. Type in the amount bid for each licence unit sought. Enter whole dollars only. Enter 0 for zero bids.

N.B. REGISTRATION NUMBER: this is your tendering Registration Number supplied to you by the Registrar of Tenderers. This is a number of up to four digits.

IMPORTER'S CODE: this is a six digit figure followed by an alphabetic letter. It is obtained from the Customs Department. *It is essential* for us to be able to put this number on your licence before we can issue it. The number is also used as a cross check on your identity in the computer programme. This number once supplied to the Registrar also appears on your registration label. If it is not on the label, please obtain and type into the box provided.

Terms and Conditions

Tenders for Round 49 must be received by the Registrar no later than 5 p.m. on Monday 22 June 1987.

Licence Periods

All licences won in this tender round will be valid for the period 1 July 1987 to 30 June 1988.

Australian Origin Goods

All licences won in this tender round are available only for the importation of goods of Australian origin as defined in the Customs Regulations 1968, as amended. The New Zealand/Australia Rules of Origin are also detailed in Article 3 of the Australian New Zealand Closer Economic Relations Trade Agreement.

Classification of Goods

Many goods that are otherwise subject to global import control are exempt when of Australian origin. It is the tenderer's responsibility to ensure the correct classification and licence status of the goods to be imported.
