Note: Arising from the Government's August 1988 decisions on the Apparel Tariff and Access Review, all apparel goods still on licence are scheduled to become exempt from import licence control on 1 July 1992. The amount tendered in this allocation has been reduced to reflect the shortened (10 month) period for which these goods will be subject to import licence. No refunds will be made on unused balances.

Tenderers should be aware that, as part of a wider investigation, a Caucus Sub-Committee has recently reviewed assistance to the apparel industry, and that government decisions have yet to be made in relation to the recommendations made by that Sub-Committee.
